Great Reasons to make a Hay Bale Art Creation:

- Great opportunity for community involvement and to be associated with HBG!
- Promote yourself or your company (via name plaque at art display) to all visitors to the Garden during September and October and through our newsletter and web site.

Tips for Making a Hay Bale Art Piece:

- The hay bales are the round type. There is a limit of two per design.
- Painting the bales takes a lot of paint. Spray paint works better than rolling paint with a roller. The paint will fade some from the sun overtime outside.
- Bales can be stacked up to two high. We will do this for you with our equipment. Square bales can also be used to compliment the design.
- The designer must supply all supplies needed to create the design.
- Designers can arrange to drive out to their design to unload supplies and work on design. Designers have approximately three weeks in August to work on their design and have it ready by September 1.
- Hay bales are on display September and October as part of the Scarecrow Trail.
