Language and Literacy

- Alphabet recognition
- Phonemic awareness
- Storytelling and reading aloud
- Vocabulary development
- Early writing skills

Mathematics

- Number recognition and counting
- Basic shapes and patterns
- Simple addition and subtraction
- Understanding sizes and measurements
- Sorting and classifying objects

Science and Nature

- Exploring plants and animals
- Weather and seasons
- Basic physics concepts (e.g., sink and float)
- Health
- Environmental awareness

Social Studies

- Community helpers and roles
- Family and cultural awareness
- Maps and geography basics
- Understanding rules and responsibilities

Creative Arts

- Drawing and painting
- Music and rhythm
- Dramatic play and puppetry
- Dance and movement
- Crafting with various materials

Physical Development

- Gross motor skills (e.g., running, jumping)
- Fine motor skills (e.g., cutting, threading)
- Coordination and balance activities
- Outdoor play and physical education

Social and Emotional Development

- Building friendships and social skills
- Understanding and expressing emotions
- Problem-solving and conflict resolution
- Empathy and cooperation
- Developing independence and self-regulation

Cognitive Development

- Critical thinking and questioning
- Memory games and puzzles
- Following multi-step instructions
- Imaginative and pretend play
- Simple cause-and-effect experiments
